# About FMAS



Registered in 1972, we are the standard bearer for financial markets' professionals in Singapore. Our history has been inextricably linked to Singapore's emergence as a leading financial centre in the world.

Financial Markets Association of Singapore (formerly known as ACI Singapore) is affiliated to ACI – The Financial Markets Association (ACI FMA), a Paris-based global umbrella body of financial markets associations. The Association was officially renamed to Financial Markets Association of Singapore on 31st March 2021 to reflect a stronger focus on the domestic agenda and is still affiliated with ACI FMA.

Our Executive Committee had recommended that the association should adopt a progressive mentality and refocus our efforts to promote the association's key objective of fostering collaboration within the financial market ecosystem. This includes promoting and supporting all participants who supports the front office of financial market in Singapore, such as the treasury middle and back office, the risk and compliance professions and recognised market operators in the ecosystem.

As the Industry representative for Financial Markets professionals, FMAS is proud that for the past 32 years to have been able to raise over \$15 million for the less fortunate in our society through our annual Charity fundraising initiatives. All funds raised is distributed from the FMAS Trampoline Fund through a grant call. This charity drive is now well recognised as a fixture in the annual calendar, and is widely and actively supported by our members and the wider financial markets fraternity.

In 2021, FMAS organized the inaugural Asia Financial Markets Forum 2021 (AFMF2021), an event especially relevant to the treasury and markets function in banks, financial institutions and corporates who face major challenges in how to stay ahead of the ever-changing environment. The headwinds created by the COVID-19 pandemic and the use of artificial intelligence have further accelerated the transition towards a more digital customer base and workforce, leading to a world where growth prospects are highly challenged, and this makes it more important to have a forum to share the information and progress in markets with all.

This year, the AFMF 2026 will be held on 22 September. FMAS hopes that by establishing this as an annual forum, it would help to bring in the fraternity of top thought leaders and establishes lasting networking within our financial markets eco system. # About FMAS Trampoline Fund

The FMAS Trampoline Fund is a partnership fund administered by The Majority Trust, supporting nonprofit programmes and initiatives that address the longer-term needs of vulnerable families and communities in Singapore.

Inspired by President Tharman Shanmugaratnam's metaphor that social assistance should serve less as a safety net and more as a trampoline, the FMAS Trampoline Fund aims to enable those in need not only to survive, but to rebound and thrive.

This philosophy is rooted in the belief that providing support to those willing to help themselves can foster a transformative culture. It aims to sustain an environment where individuals can take pride in their achievements and attain success on their own terms. Therefore, the Fund focuses on supporting programs that help vulnerable and disadvantaged communities enhance their capabilities to improve their own lives.

Since 2020, the FMAS Trampoline Fund has raised \$3.76 million, supporting over 90 projects. In 2025, FMAS raised \$512,418 at the 2025 FMAS Charity Golf Fundraiser, committing \$362,500 to support 13 grantee partners who have reached 12,803 beneficiaries.

## 1. REGISTRATION & COLLECTION OF GOODIE BAGS

- 1.1. Registration will open from 11:00, Fri 15 May 2026.
- 1.2. Please collect your Goodie Bag on registration.
- 1.3. To ensure you have ample time to change and lunch, kindly arrive and register at least one (1) hour before the 12:45 shotgun tee-time.
- 1.4. Buffet lunch will be served at the Grand Ballroom (Level 3), at SICC Island Location.

## 2. SHOTGUN TEE-TIME

- 2.1. Golfers are kindly reminded to register at least one (1) hour before the 12:45 shotgun tee-time.
- 2.2. All golfers are to assemble near the Golfers' Buggy station at about 12:25 for a group photo taking session.
- 2.3. All golfers will then proceed to your respective assigned immediately after the group photo and to get ready to move off to tee boxes.

## 3. TOURNAMENT RULES

### 3.1. **Format of Play: TEXAS SCRAMBLE.**

FMAS Charity Golf 2026 is a tournament consisting of a single round of 18 holes played in a **Texas Scramble**, shotgun tee-time format, on the stipulated event day only.

Texas Scramble, which is also called a 'Scramble', shall be played with every flight forming a team.

Every golfer in the same flight shall tee-off individually. The team/flight decides which shot to take, which is usually but not always, the 'best'. This could be based on distance, position and/or ease of the next shot. All other tee-shots will not be taken. All members of the team/flight will place their golf balls where the chosen tee shot ended up, and from there they all play the second shot. This process is repeated until the ball is holed.

Each team/flight returns one GROSS score for each hole which will be recorded on one (1) scorecard.

# Golf Tournament Rules

- 3.2. **No handicap:** There will be no handicap applied to the recorded and submitted gross scores.
- 3.3. **Tee-Boxes:** All men will tee-off from the WHITE tees while the ladies will tee-off from the RED tees.
- 3.4. **Gimme Putt:** A 'Gimme' shall apply when the ball lies within a putter's length not including its grip (approximately 24 inches or 60 centimetres). Pick up the ball and add one (1) stroke to the score. Move on to the next hole.
- 3.5. **Tournament Prizes:** All completed scorecards will be computed and tabulated from the lowest to the highest gross scores and tournament prizes will be awarded accordingly. In the event if the tournament cannot be completed for whatever reason, tournament prizes shall be distributed based on a lucky draw format.
- 3.6. **Score Card:** All Score Cards must be submitted to the officials after the round. Please enter only the GROSS score for each hole. Please check that your scores are entered correctly and legibly. Incorrect, illegible and/or incomplete scorecards shall be deemed as non-submitted scores and will not be computed and tabulated. The Singapore Island Country Club, on behalf of the FMAS Charity Golf 2026 Organising Committee, will compute the results for the Tournament.
- 3.7. **Speed and Pace of Play:** Slow and inconsiderate Play will not be accepted. Golfers must abide and take precautions for safe play at all times. In the interest of all players in the tournament, please ensure that your flight keeps pace at a safe distance from the flight ahead. The Tournament Organisers and SICCC officials reserve the right to make suggestions to players and their flights to speed up play. To speed up play, you are encouraged to apply the Gimme Putt and Ready Golf. Please adhere to all safe management measures and SICCC rules at all times.
- 3.8. **Suspension of Play Due to a Dangerous Situation**
- 3.8.1. When play is suspended by the Organising Committee for a dangerous situation, if the golfers are between the play of two holes, they must not resume play until the Organising Committee has issued a resumption of play. If they are in the process of playing a hole, they must discontinue play immediately and not resume play until the Organising Committee has issued a resumption of play. If a golfer fails to discontinue play immediately, he/she is disqualified, unless circumstances warrant waiving the penalty as provided in Rule 33-7.
- 3.8.2. The signal for suspending play due to a dangerous situation will be based on the siren system at SICCC.

# Golf Tournament Rules

- 3.9. **Incomplete Tournament:** In the event if the tournament is incomplete for whatsoever reason, tournament prizes may be awarded via a lucky draw or as the committee determines.
- 3.10. **Rules of Golf and Local Rules:** Rules of golf has prescribed by the R&A, USGA and the local rules of The Singapore Island Country Club (SICC) shall apply.

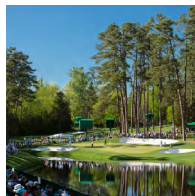
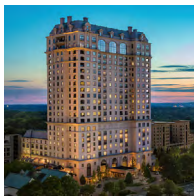
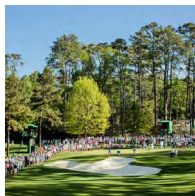
